### Fundraising

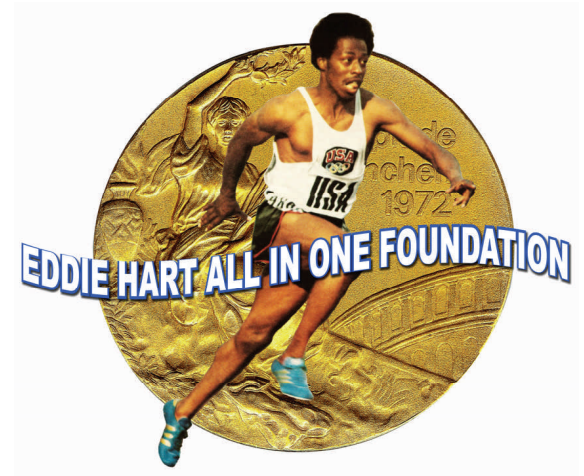
- Raised enough to make all of our events for 2006 a huge success.

## Who is Eddie Hart ? The Founder of the Eddie Hart All In One Foundation

Eddie is Internationally known as one of the world's greatest sprinters, Eddie Hart has established his place in history. From his early days in Pittsburg, CA., where he grew up, he experienced athletic success. Mr. Hart attended the University of California, Berkeley and graduated in 1975 with a degree in Physical Education.



Prior to Mr. Hart's graduation he made history when he and Isaac Curtis finished 1st and 2nd at the National Collegiate Athletic Association Championships, at Des Moines, Iowa in 1970. A feat that still stands today, over thirty-three years later. In 1972 Eddie equaled the world record in the 100 meters winning the finals at the Olympic Trials in Eugene, OR. He also completed on the US Olympic team in the 4x100 meter relay, which broke the world record, making him an Olympic Gold Medalist and Olympic record holder.

Unfortunately, Eddie was unable to compete in his specialty, the 100 meters, because the sprint coach for the US Olympic Track and Field Team had the wrong time schedule. Eddie and Rey Robinson subsequently missed their quarterfinal heat, eliminating them from the Olympic 100 meter competition.

Today Eddie is still very active and currently holds the 100 meters world record, master division for ages forty to forty-four. Now over fifty he is training to compete in the next US Masters Championships.

Eddie has been living with his family in Pittsburg for the past 14 years. Now that he has reached his goals and dreams, he believes it is time for him to help the youth in the surrounding community to develop and attain their goals and dreams. That's why he felt compelled to start the Eddie Hart All In One Foundation. To use his name, influence, relationships and resources to make a positive difference in the lives of youth.
